## I. From Death to Life (2:1-10)

- A. Man's Problem: [2:1-3]
  - 1. Dead in trespasses and sins [1]
  - 2. Walking (living) according to the fallen world [2]
  - 3. Subjects of Satan [2]
  - 4. Children of disobedience [2]
  - 5. Living as a slaves to our own passions [3]
  - 6. Children of (destined for) wrath [3]
- B. God's Grace intervenes: (But God!) [2:4-6]
  - 1. Rich Mercy, great love [4]
  - 2. Made alive in Christ [5]
  - 3. Saved by grace [5]
  - 4. Raised with Christ [6]
  - 5. Seated in heavenly places with Christ [6]
- C. God's Purpose: [2:7-10]
  - 1. A display of immeasurably rich grace and kindness [7]
  - 2. The salvation of individuals is all of God [8]
  - 3. We contribute nothing, but appropriate by faith [9]
  - 4. Saved for the purpose of displaying God's handiwork (workmanship) [10]

## II. Brought Near, Made One [2:11-22]

- A. What We Were As Unbelieving Gentiles [2:11-12]
  - 1. "The uncircumcision" National and natural animosity [11]
  - 2. Separate from Christ [12]
  - 3. Excluded from the commonwealth of Israel (God's covenant people) [12]
  - 4. Strangers to the covenants of promise [12]
  - 5. Having no hope [12]
  - 6. Without God in the world. [12]
- B. New Relationship in Christ (But now!) [2:13-22]
  - 1. Formerly far off brought near by the blood of Christ [13]
  - 2. At enmity with God He Himself is our peace [14]
  - 3. Two warring factions made into one [14]
  - 4. Separated (Jew and Gentile) He broke down the barrier of the dividing wall [14]
  - 5. Abolishing in His flesh the source of enmity Law of commandments contained in ordinances [15]
  - 6. Making out of two one new man [15]
  - 7. Establishing peace (between Jew and Gentile believers) [15]
  - 8. Reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross [16]
  - 9. Putting an end to natural hostility (between believers) [16]
  - 10. He came and preached peace to you who were far away (Gentiles), and peace to those who were near (Jews) [17]
  - 11. Through Him we both have our access in one Spirit to the Father [18]
  - 12. No longer strangers and aliens, but fellow citizens with the saints [19]
  - 13. Of God's household [19]
  - 14. Growing into a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are being built together into a dwelling of God in the Spirit. All built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets (the word of God), Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone. [20-21]
